#### **GOSPEL MEDITATION**

What is the secret to sharing in God's power to overcome our difficulties? Mary teaches us this in the prophecy of her pierced heart. This Sunday, the old man Simeon prophecies that when her son faces opposition, Mary's soul will be pierced by a sword. The seemingly pointless agony of a mother helplessly watching her son be mocked, tortured, killed and then cruelly desecrated in death by a spear — somehow this piercing of her heart releases a power by which "the thoughts of many hearts may be revealed" (Luke 2:35). What to make of this?

Whatever problems we currently face, the deepest threat is finally that evil thoughts are hidden in the human heart: hatred, envy, pride, lust, greed and so on. Behind every tyrant's injustice, for example, is a heart unpierced by love. Evil hides in our hearts. Mary's pierced heart, and its suffering love for her son, reveals and scatters these evil thoughts, and replaces them with love, forgiveness, generosity and peace.

This week, I invite us to ponder Mary's pierced heart. Her heart is quietly at work for us in the Church and world, exposing our evil thoughts and making a path for her son's divine love. This is how she gently cooperates in our salvation. Closed hearts are our biggest problem; love-pierced hearts are the ultimate power to overcome every difficulty.

#### The Theology of the Candle

Dear Parishioners of St. Maurice,

Have you ever wondered why we use candle in the liturgy and for other devotionals?

Candles are used at Mass and in our churches for a very import reason

<u>THE FLAME</u> - represents Christ as the Light of the World. <u>THE WICK</u> - symbolizes Christ's divinity which is hidden by His humanity (symbolized by the wax).

<u>THE WAX -</u> of the candle symbolizes Christ's humanity which hides His divinity (symbolized by the wick).

As the candle burns, it gets smaller and smaller, in a sense, it sacrifices itself, symbolizing how Christ sacrificed Himself on the cross of our salvation.

The wax itself is made by female worker bees who never mate (virgins) and further symbolizes Christ's perfect purity.

As Lent approaches, the time to think about our new Paschal Candle is here. Each year the parish purchases a new Paschal, or Easter Candle, symbolizing Christ.

This year, I invite any parishioner who wishes to donate the Paschal Candle in memorial of a loved to please speak to me. By doing so, your loved ones will be remembered each time the paschal candle is lite for Baptisms and Funerals.

In addition, I would like to begin offering the Sanctuary Candle as another memorial opportunity for parishioners. The Sanctuary Candle will burn for 14-days in memory of your deceased loved ones, or for another special intentions. The cost of the 14-day Sanctuary Candle Memorial Gift will be \$25.00

These are just two ways we can remember our deceased loved ones.

If you would like to memorialize either the Paschal Candle or the 14-day sanctuary candle, please speak to me and we can make it happen.
